

### EAST SVEADAHL LUTHERAN CHURCH COUNCIL MINUTES - February 8, 2024

The East Sveadahl Church Council met on Thursday, February 8, 2024 at 7 pm at East Sveadahl. Those present were Tom Anderson, Janet Bloomquist, Kris Suess, Dana Avila, Lori Urevig, Sonja Coleman, and Pastor Mandy.

Absent: Cindy Torkelson & Susan Anderson

Tom Anderson, Council Chairman, called the meeting to order.

Pastor Mandy opened with prayer.

The January 11, 2024 minutes were approved as written in the newsletter.

Sonja Coleman, Financial Secretary and Treasurer, Kris Suess presented their reports. A motion by Dana, seconded by Janet, and passed to approve the reports as presented.

Tom presented the bills. The Aadland Pipe Organ Co., Art Aadland, has been working on repairs for the church organ. The cost for the first repairs were \$3,585.00, and the additional cost for the new power supply is \$2,508.00. A motion by Dana, seconded by Lori and passed to approve paying of bills.

The noisy offering for December 2023 and January 2024 was \$106.44. It was decided to add the February noisy offering and split the total  $\frac{1}{2}$  to St. James and  $\frac{1}{2}$  LaSalle Fire Departments.

- The first Bible Study with the youth who are attending the National Youth Conference was held and well attended. There are 14 youth and 4 adults attending. Erick Avila will be attending the MYLE (Multicultural Youth Leadership Event) which will be held prior to the Youth Conference.
- Look forward to the following dates where the ROAR youth will be singing at East Sveadahl during the service February 25 and April 28.

### **Pastor Mandy presented her report:**

- Sunday, February 18, will be the installation of the AES and church council members at both churches.
- Wednesday, February 14 is Ash Wednesday & Valentines Day. There will be a Valentines Party at ROAR and a noon drive by for Ashes at Augustana along with a 6:30 p.m. Ash Wednesday Service at Augustana. East will be serving the Wednesday suppers on February 28 and March 13. See the February newsletters for complete schedule for Lent.
- Sunday, February 28 is the Watonwan River Conference at 2 p.m. at Trinity in Madelia. All are invited.

# ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES OF EAST SVEADAHL LUTHERAN CHURCH - February 4, 2024 153<sup>rd</sup> ANNUAL MEETING OF EAST SVEADAHL LUTHERAN CHURCH

The 153<sup>rd</sup> annual meeting of the East Sveadahl Lutheran Church was held on Sunday, February 4, 2024 following the Sunday Service and a potluck dinner with 22 members in attendance.

Chairman, Tom Anderson opened the meeting by thanking everyone for coming.

Pastor Mandy opened with a prayer.

A motion by Wayne Jurgens, seconded by Dana Avila, and passed to accept the 152<sup>nd</sup> Annual Meeting Minutes as printed in the 2023 Annual Report.

Tom highlighted some of the congregational statistics from page 5 of the annual meeting report.

The financial and written reports of the church organizations were highlighted and approved as written. Tom thanked Sonja Coleman, Financial Secretary and Kris Suess, Treasurer for volunteering their time for their positions.

Pastor Mandy highlighted the on-line giving option for church donations. Anyone interested should contact Sonja Coleman, Financial Secretary.

Pastor Mandy commented on her report as written in the annual report: 1) this was the first annual Ecumenical Bible School with First Lutheran, First Presbyterian and AES Ministries and another is being planned for 2024,

2) Pastor Mandy participated in the Butterfield Threshing Bee's Sunday Service for the first time. Pastor Mandy stated that God rejoices when Christians come together and that part of ministry is sharing stories.

Tom commented on the Bible Studies at East following the Sunday services as very uplifting and is hopeful that they will continue.

Tom presented the nominating committee ballot for 2024. As all positions on the ballot are filled by volunteers, a motion by Janet Bloomquist, seconded by Fran Anderson, and passed to accept a unanimous ballot. The results of the ballot are as follows: (All volunteered for the positions)

The Cemetery Association meeting was held with Wes Beck presiding.

The East Sveadahl annual meeting resumed with the following:

#### **Old Business:**

• The organ was in need of repair and the cost was \$3,585.00.

#### **New Business:**

- AES Council consists of 8 members 2 from each church council and 2 at large. For 2024 the East Council members for AES Council will be Dana Avila (1 year remaining) and Tom Anderson (volunteered for another 2 year term) and the at large members will be Lori Urevig (2 year term) and Teresa Andrews (1 year remaining).
- The 2024 East Sveadahl Lutheran Church budget proposal was presented. A motion Lynne Rolshoven, seconded by Sonja Coleman, and passed to approve the proposed 2024 budget with one correction the total budget amount should be \$95,390.00. It was noted that the East portion of the AES Parish Administration costs for 2024 are 34% and Augustana is 66%.
- The 2024 East Sveadahl Proposed Resolutions were read. A motion by Lisa Shellum, seconded by Bernie Jurgens, and passed to adopt the resolutions as presented.

Special thanks was given by Sonja Coleman, Financial Secretary, for the great monetary support from everyone, and Tom Anderson thanked Pastor Mandy for all her work with AES Ministries and that we are very thankful to have her.

As there was no other business, a motion by Janet Bloomquist, seconded by Tammy Stevens Rathman, and passed to adjourn.

We closed with the Lord's Prayer.

#### AUGUSTANA LUTHERAN CHURCH ANNUAL MEETING - JANUARY 28, 2024

President Mark Kulseth called the meeting to order at 9:59 am.

Pastor Mandy led us in the Opening Litany.

Time was given for congregation members to read over last year's Annual meeting minutes from January 22, 2023. These minutes were approved and seconded with no one opposed.

Committee and organization reports are posted in the Annual Report. Please contact a committee member if you have any questions.

Mark Larson presented the Audit Committee report. The Audit Committee-Mark Larson, Jackie Harrington and Jim Moody-did review the books for Augustana and found no issues.

Judy Thulien presented the Treasurer's Report, also announcing that she is planning to retire on June 30, 2024. The Thrivent Annuity was cashed in so this will no longer be listed under Income. Noted \$14,748 over budget. Fund Activity Report and Money Market Memorial Savings as listed in the report.

President Mark Kulseth informed the congregation that the building insurance increased to \$14,000 in 2024. It was decided to stay with the current insurance company with a few changes to the policy. The church was insured for 1.7 million with a \$3,000 deductible. This will change to a \$20,00 deductible, insured for 1 million at the cost of \$10,000 for 2024, approximately \$5,000 in savings. The amount of money from the CD that matures on June 13, 2024 will be moved to the Building/Insurance Deductible account under Memorial Savings. There was a motion to approve the Treasurer's report, seconded, and no one opposed.

Question regarding the Thrivent Choice dollars that was kept in a savings account. This money was disbursed between the youth, Men's group, WELCA, and music /technology. You have to have a Thrivent policy and you also have to notify Thrivent if you would like your money sent to this account. Contact Tim Flitter for information as to how this can be done and to explain the Thrivent Choice dollars and Thrivent gift cards.

Reflections of success: VBS, AES Joint picnic, St, Lucia, and 14 youth that will attend the National Gathering, just to name a few.

Augustana Church council: Terry Engel reported for the nominating committee. Mark Kulseth and Lisa Carlson completed a 6-year term and Kristi Zellmann decided not to run again. Jill Beckius agreed to a second term. Jim Harrington, Margo (Engel) Spang, and Doug Erdal will fill the other seats. Lyle Anderson was voted to serve as an Augustana council representative to the AES Joint Council, if he is willing to serve. Member at large, Lisa Carlson was voted for a 2-year term to AES Joint Council. Next council meeting will be Tuesday, February 13, 24 with Ash Wednesday on February 14, 24.

Proposed Budget for 2024-Judy noted that there was one correction under Pastoral Expense: Pension & Insurance @ 74% should be 66%; the other 34% from East Sveadahl. This is based on the CCC's from each congregation. Judy does not receive these numbers until January. Mark Kulseth stated that cuts to the budget were made as much as possible. Motion to approve the Budget was made and seconded.

Jim and Shirley Moody will focus on mutual ministry within the congregation.

Question was made regarding an updated membership list.

Stan called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm

Jim Moody presented a report regarding the cemetery. Stated he would like to get a group together this spring to find all the aluminum markers on all cemetery plots.
